



Appendix D: American Sign Language (ASL), Spanish, and Translation of Key Terms

These steps will assign a Grade 8 Social Studies student to the correct test session for either the ASL (American Sign Language), Spanish, or Keyword Translation accommodation.

1. From *Setup > Students*, select the Select Tasks dropdown and click the checkboxes next to the appropriate task(s).

- 4. Next, make the appropriate choice for which accommodation the student needs.
 - For ASL, select the checkbox next to American Sign Language.
 - For Spanish, select the dropdown under Spanish.
 - For Keyword Translation, select the correct language in the dropdown under Translation of Key Terms Language.

5. For ASL and Spanish, accommodation indicators will be available on the Students in Sessions screen, next to the SSID. Check that it says either "ASL" or "S" next to the SSID to ensure that the student is in the correct session. Note: There is no indicator for Keyword Translation.
